BRIEF ON MESCO TRAINING CENTER: BULDHANA

Maharashtra Ex-servicemen Corporation Ltd (MESCO) was established vide Maharashtra state Govt. GR in 2002 and registered under company's act 1965.

- 1. <u>Introduction:</u> The Mahasainik Training center was established on 15 June 2015 as one of the vertical of MESCO at BULDHANA. The objective is to generate job opportunities for youth of Maharashtra especially from Marathwada and Vidarbha, and socially lift the youth from the backward(less developed) areas.
- 2. <u>Aim:</u> The training center is a welfare venture with the aim to encourage youth of Maharashtra to secure job in uniform.
- 3. <u>Scope:</u> The training is imparted for Pre Recruitment Training for Military, Para Military and Police force. The training center also trains wards of Ex-servicemen and civilians who aspire to make their carrier as Security Guard.
- 4. <u>Training:</u> The training center imparts residential training, and candidates from far districts subscribe for the course due to the standard and infrastructure. This center has trained more than 2700 aspirants which includes 300 ladies since its inception in 2015.
- 5. The courses offered are:
 - a) Pre recruitment Training course (PRTC) for Military, Para Military and Police force spanning for 90 days.
 - b) Security Guard Training for wards of ex-servicemen and civilian, spanning for three weeks (21 days).
- 6. <u>Training Facilities:</u> The training is imparted to gents and ladies for the above mentioned courses as per their requirement. The training involves preparing the aspirants for written and physical tests by team of ex-servicemen instructors with vast military experience.
 - a) Physical training: The physical tests are pre requisite before undertaking the written test and needs more effort. To ensure that the candidates achieve the required physical standard, the training is imparted by dedicated physical training instructors. The center has:
 - i) One 350 meters running track
 - ii) Obstacle training field consisting of vertical rope, monkey rope, nine feet ditch, Zigzag obstacle as per required standard of Army and Police force.
 - iii) The kits for ground events like high jump, shot-put.
 - iv) A gymnasium for strengthening exercise.
 - v) The candidates are trained on cross country tracks at regular intervals as part of stamina building exercise.
 - b) <u>Academic Training:</u> The center has furnished class rooms with overhead projectors and Public address system. The experienced and dedicated instructors asses the performance of the candidates at regular intervals and give them tips to perform better

- to crack the exam. TV and News papers are made available to update about the national and international developments.
- c) Sports Facilities: In order to ensure overall development of the aspirants, the center has facilities like volley ball ground, football ground and indoor games like carom board, chess etc.
- 7. **Boarding & lodging:** The training for ladies and gents is residential training to ensure continued presence and focused training for the aspirants. The center has a capacity to accommodate 120 candidates in two dormitories and dedicated dormitories for ladies and gents, with same capacity in the dining hall. The center has 24 hours water supply with solar powered hot water and uninterrupted power with battery backup. The nutritious food is prepared in-house by cooks as per the weekly menu to meet the nutritious requirement of the body, aspirant's tastes and availability of local variety.
- 8. <u>Fees structure</u>: The fees is structured keeping in mind the welfare mission of MESCO, affordability of the aspirants from the rural part of the state and backwardness of Vidarbha and Marathwada.
 - a) The Pre Recruitment Course Training -For duration of 90 day-Rs. 30,000 (Excluding GST) $100 \times 30,000 = 30,00,000/-$ (excluding 18 % GST 9 % CGST & 9 % SGST)
 - b) The Security Guard course -For duration of 21 day- Rs. 9000/-(Excluding GST) $20 \times 9,000/-=1,80,000/-$ For three courses of 20 students each in three months $3 \times 1,80,000/-=5,40,000/-$ (Excluding 18 % GST -9 % CGST & 9 % SGST)
- 9. <u>Planning for 2022-23</u>: The courses mentioned at para.7 above are planned for the Academic year. The center is training private (self financed) aspirants and candidates sponsored by Adivasi developments departments like Shabari. The aspirants from far flung districts of the state patronises this training center because of the quality of training and the infrastructure.
