

## SHORT BRIEF OF INCIDENT

1. On 10 Oct 2023 at 0830hrs, one of the on duty Life Guard realised that there is an unusual gas spread in the air and went immediately to check water filter system, wherein he noticed that chlorine gas is leaking from cylinder. He immediately alerted everyone by blowing continues whistle and thereafter activated existing electric alarm system. All five MESCO Life Guards and Adm Incharge rushed to pool and evacuated all 25 civilians from the pool premises without caring for self. While doing so, they were badly affectd due to exposure to chlorine gas leakage and have to admitted to nearest hospital of PCMC.

2. We soldier have been taught to care for others safety at the time of emergency before caring for self. MESCO NO - 07114 Kadam Sachin Chandrakant, MESCO No - 07097 Pandurang Kacharu Kulange, MESCO No – 07121 Panaskar Dadaso Rajaram, MESCO No - 7105 Rajkumar Jadhav and MESCO No - 07237 Jamdade Jayant Kalidas, Adm Incharge displayed decisiveness, determination and devotion to duty at the time of extreme emergency of chlorine gas leakage at Kasarwadi Swimming Pool and contributed in saving precious civilian lives. Their act of courage and selflessness was well recognised and appreciated by Commissioner PCMC and Mr Mahesh Landge, local MLA. The attentiveness and timely response shown by MESCO Life Guards has not only motivated the other MESCO Security Guards but also in turn helped to boost MESCO image.
